Welcome Back and Welcome to our New School

Welcome back to the new year at ISSR and welcome to our new school. Everyone is quickly finding their way around the building and our new improved classrooms! As you can probably see, the roof is still being built over our swimming pool and we are hoping it will be finished in September. Drop off each morning

We now have a larger drop off area for the children each morning. When dropping off your child at school, please drive all the way to the end so that we can allow more children to get out of cars at the same time. Stopping outside the gate will just slow up the process and mean that parents behind you will have to wait longer. TAs and guards will not open the door until each car has moved as far along as they can. Your cooperation in this will lead to a much smoother drop off system in the morning. For motorbikes, there is a special area to the right of the building where they can be parked for drop off each morning. If you wish to drive up to the gate, please stay to the left and do not cut in front of cars.

Class Dojo

We will be continuing to use Class Dojo as a way to communicate with parents. We received very positive feedback from parents about it last year and we found it is a great way to keep you up to date on what is happening in your child's class. It is also a convenient way to keep up communication between home and school. If you signed up last year, there is no need to sign up again. Once your child is added to their new class, each attached email address will automatically be assigned to that class. If you are new to the school, your child's class teacher will be sending home an invitation to join.



Lunchtimes

We now have enough space and playgrounds for the children to all enjoy lunchtime from 12-12:45pm. Thank you to our Reception 2 parents who have been helping settle in the children to full-time school. We continue to welcome you until Friday 31st August. From Monday 3rd September the school will take over full responsibility for lunchtime supervision. Thank you for your support during this time of transition for your child.

Late Arrival at School

From 3rd September we will be starting a late book which will be kept at the entrance to the school. If you arrive after 8am this will need to be signed with the time of arrival and the reason for being late. Lateness in a class can disrupt the flow of a lesson, distract other students, impede learning, and generally erode class morale. So, please think of all the students in your child's class and ensure you are on time, or even better, early for school each day.


Medicine in School

We understand that sometimes your child will have to take medicine but they will be well enough to attend school. Any medicine that a child needs to take **must be brought to the school office** where it will be kept until it needs to be taken. Parents should ensure that instructions for how and when the medicine is to be taken is also brought in with the medicine. Please note: School staff do not administer medicine to students without parental consent. When medicine is brought into school a record of the medicine taken is also recorded.

Water Bottles

Students must only bring water to school in non-breakable containers. Glass is not permitted on the school grounds.
