The school year has started and the nursery classroom is now filled with lovely and adorable little ones. I am wishing a successful and a very positive experience for this class. Here's an update on what we have been learning in class.



Phase 1 Letters and Sounds

The beginning of Phase 1 Letters and Sounds is all about learning and practicing to be an attentive listener. By being a good listener we will also become a good speaker. We have been doing activities on how to monitor our own volume of sounds at the right time such as when to be loud, when to use our indoor voices and when to be quiet. We use the sounds from the environment, the sounds from our body and also the sounds from musical instruments for our auditory practice. We have been listening to, making quiet and loud sounds as well as singing songs to help us with our listening and speaking skills.



Topic: I am Special

As we begin learning, we want to know about ourselves first, thus our topic, "I am Special". We have finished learning and doing activities about 'My Body and My Family'. Next week, we are going to learn as many Nursery Rhymes and songs as we can. Nursery Rhymes and songs can help young children develop their language and communication skills from an early age.



Maths

Our very first Maths topic is counting small numbers. We have been doing activities such as counting numbers from 1 to 5, familiarising ourselves with each numeral, counting classroom items, our 5 fingers, as well as counting in play. We also sing lots of counting songs to help us enjoy studying numbers.
