Class Dojo

We will be continuing to use Class Dojo as a way to communicate with parents. It is a convenient way to keep up communication between home and school and for parents to update teachers with necessary information. If you signed up last year, there is no need to sign up again. Once your child is added to their new class, each attached email address will automatically be assigned to that class. If you are new to the school, your child's class teacher will be sending home an invitation to join.

Thank you to our Reception 2 parents who have been helping settle in the children to full-time school. We continue to welcome you until Friday 30th August. From Monday 2nd September the school will take over full responsibility for lunchtime supervision. Thank you for your support during this time of transition for your child.

We will be holding our annual Meet & Greet Evening on **Friday 30th August at 5pm**. We welcome all parents to attend as it is a great opportunity to visit your child's class and get to know their class teacher. Afterwards, snacks and drinks will be available. Please be aware that this is not an individual parent meeting about your child and if you would like to discuss your child, you will need to make an appointment through the office. Late Arrival at School


From 2nd September, any late arrivals will need to go straight to the office and sign the late book. The guards will close the gate at 8am so if your child arrives after this time, they will need to gain access to the school through the office. Lateness in a class can disrupt the flow of a lesson, distract other students, impede learning, and generally erode class morale. So, please think of all the students in your child's class and ensure you are on time, or even better, early for school each day.

Medicine in School

We understand that sometimes your child will have to take medicine but they will be well enough to attend school. Any medicine that a child needs to take **must be brought to the school and administer by the parent.**Please note: School staff will not administer medicine to students. Please do not send your child to school if they have a fever, have vomited or have untreated headlice.

Water Bottles

Students must only bring water to school in non-breakable containers. Glass is not permitted on the school grounds.
