

If your child has a case of vomiting, fever or head lice, they must be kept at home until they have recovered. If we suspect one of these cases or your child falls ill at school, we will call and ask you to collect your child from school.

If your child has an ailment that does not otherwise prevent their presence in school, we cannot take responsibility for administering medicine. However, an arrangement can be discussed on a case-by-case basis. All medication must be clearly labelled and given to the office. Children are not allowed to take medication to their classroom. A record of all medication taken at ISSR is kept in the school office.
