Here's an update on what we have been learning in class.

Phase 1 Letters and Sounds

We have completed activities that help us monitor our own volume of sounds in the right time such as when to be loud, when to use our indoor voices and when to be quiet. We have learned words about sounds such as slow, fast, loud and quiet. I have also observed how well the children march.

Maths
