**Literacy:** We have been doing a lot of work on learning when to use capital letters and full stops in the right places. We have now started a new literacy topic looking at stories with familiar settings, using the Tiger Who Came to Tea as our focus book.

**Maths:** We have been working on adding and subtracting, number bonds to 10 and 20, telling the time and using money. We have practised adding to the next multiple of 10 and are starting to learn how to multiply by 10.
