Dear Parents/Guardians,

It's good to have the children back after the long break. It has been a great new year. The children have come a long way and they are doing a fantastic job in class. Thank you parents for your support. Here's an update on what we have been learning in class:

## Phase 1 Letters and Sounds

We are now in the Aspect 5 of Phase 1. In this aspect, we focus on developing understanding of alliteration-words that have the same sound at the beginning. Our aim is to help the children develop an ear



for sounds. Our favourite activity is called 'Sounds Around' which is a simple tongue twister activity using children's name or objects that are of particular interest to them. By learning to identify and pay close attention to the sounds in words, they'll be able to discern how different words vary in their pronunciation.

## Maths: Counting to 20

We are currently learning about numbers 1 to 20. We want to familiarize ourselves with counting from 1 to 20 by singing lots of number songs and rhymes. The month of February



will be full of number activities. Our goal is to recognise at least some of these numbers and be able to count different things correctly, counting one object in a set once, with one touch per object (like toys, objects in the pictures and movements like claps and jumps).
