MATHS

The children did a brilliant job working through our most recent topic of Addition and Subtraction. They have become skilled at using various methods to calculate answers including further developing mental strategies. This week, we have moved on to Multiplication and Division, and understanding how place value is changed when multiplying or dividing by 10 or 100.

LITERACY

Our most recent topic of Fairytales has been such fun and the children's creativity has been phenomenal! We have looked at writing from different points of view, such as retelling the classic fairytale from the view of the apple in Snow White and the 7 Dwarves. We also wrote our own play scripts using fairytale characters.

SCIENCE
