#### **Khmer National Exams**

In mid- August, we were given the official approval from the authority to conduct the Khmer National exams. A milestone for us to be recognised as a centre for conducting the 2020 National Examinations Kudos to the staff for making it possible with their dedicated hard work and contributions.













Following the approval we went on to reopen the school for the face to face lessons in September. Classrooms were arranged to meet the safety criteria directed by the authority. The year groups attended school on staged schedules. Alternate days for the lessons to avoid overcrowding and maintaining the safe Social Distancing measures. The students were excited to be back in school for the face to face lessons. Catching up with their classmates and working in a safe classroom environment. Physical contact sports and games are still not permitted. Seating arrangements were made to accommodate the safe social distancing measures while they have their breaks and lunches. Masks and face shields were worn by staff and students throughout the day. Temperatures taken twice in the day and everything went smoothly as planned.

With the positive feedbacks received from parents and stakeholders we are now anticipating a full in-house school opening in October. We are currently working on a timetable to restore the normal school hours to the new normal, post-pandemic environment.
