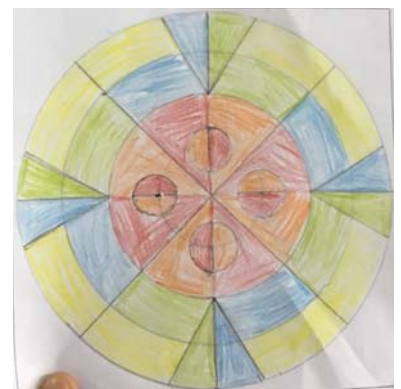

**Year 2** have had lots of fun in Maths and Science. They have explored solids, liquids and gases, and used their number skills to estimate and count accurately.

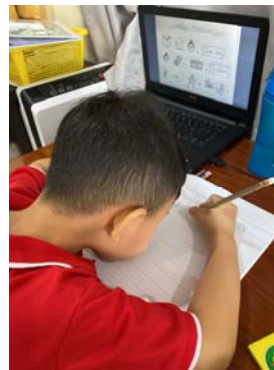

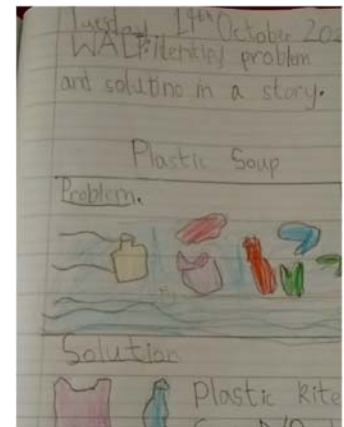

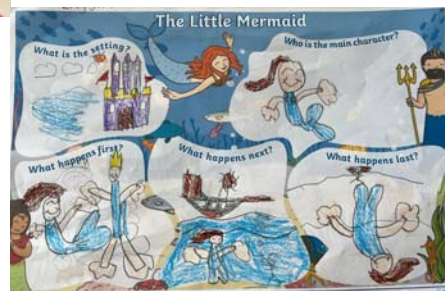
