## HOUSEKEEPING

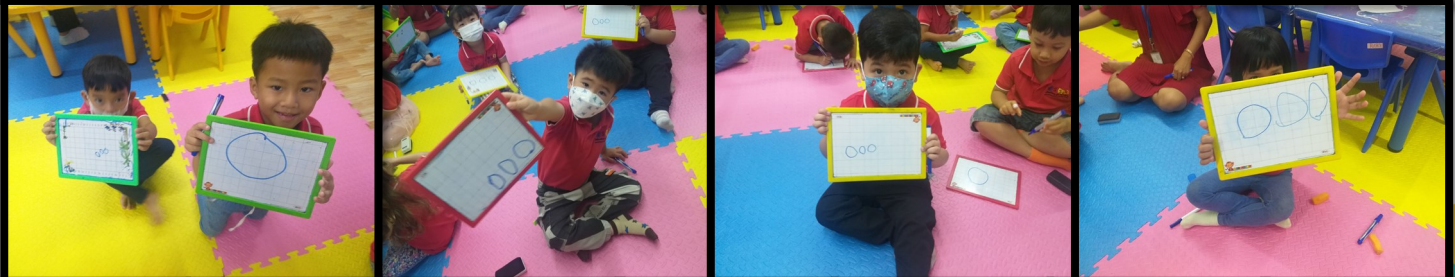
- Our class starts at 8:00am, please make sure your child is at school on time
