Maths

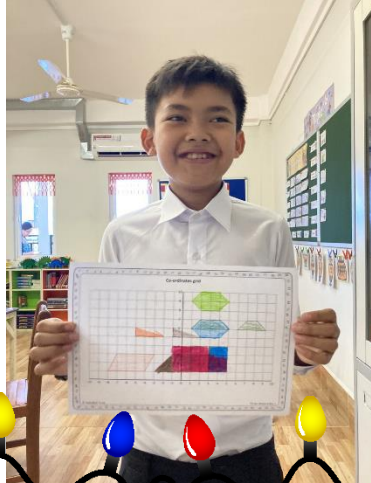
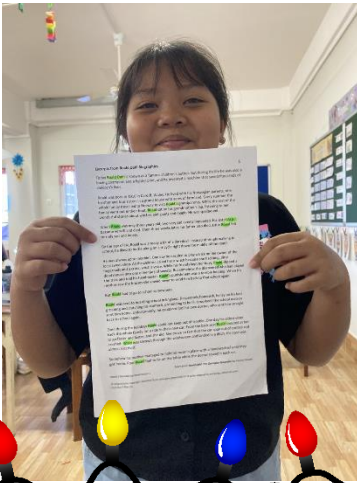
In Maths students have worked on translating different polygons on a grid. This has allowed students to practice their work on coordinates as well as translation of shapes.
