Literacy

In Literacy, students have been revising and performing a selection of classic poems.

Students will be holding poem performances in class on Monday 6th February.

More than this, students have worked on comparing character perspectives and effects of these within the story of Edward Tulane, which is the current focus of Writer's Workshop.



Maths

In Maths students have learnt how to multiply fractions with whole numbers. Students used different learning styles to achieve this, and most students have been successful in this.

Furthermore, students have focused on place value in six-digit numbers, and have been using different methods to add and subtract up to 100,000 off these numbers.

In Science, we have started our new theme about 'Properties and Changes of Materials'.

Students also conducted an experiment where they felt a material inside a bag and described its properties.
