Literacy

In Literacy, students have been working on analyzing the characters in 'Romeo and Juliet' in more depth. Students started watching the 1968 movie version of the play, and created character maps to highlight which adjectives suit the characters, and how they change during the play.

Maths

In Maths, students have been focusing on working with Roman numerals, and calculating with decimal numbers.

Students completed a test featuring content we have worked on over the past three weeks, including place value, mathematical word problems, and Roman numerals.

Science
