PHONICS

Alliteration

We have started learning about Alliteration. Our goal this week was to reproduce the initial sounds clearly and recognizably. Our first activity was "I spy name" where we played with the children's names, emphasizing the initial sound of each name. We also played tongue twister games using the children's names and objects of particular interest to them. Word play with the beginning sound is a regular occurrence this week.



NUMERACY

One more and one less

To help strengthen our number sense skills, we learnt about "one more and one less". To help us understand the concept, we used toys in baskets and toy blocks for our activity. We counted the toys in the basket, and each time a child adds one more or takes away one from the basket, we learnt that the number becomes less or more.

LITERACY/TOPIC

Topic - Likes and dislikes.

We have learnt to express ourselves with our likes and dislikes and understand that people have different preferences. Our sorting activity encouraged children to think about what they like and dislike, expand their answers, and give the reasons why.
