PHONICS

Segmenting

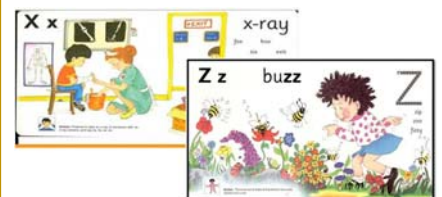
Our activity for this week was to segment words into phonemes. We used every day conversations about different scenarios, which the children were happy to talk about to the sound-talking toy. Sound-talk is modelled for the children to repeat to the toy. This is teaching the children to segment words into their separate sounds, which is the reverse of blending.

MATHS

We have been learning addition by combining two groups of objects to find how many there are all together. We also started learning subtraction by taking away objects from a group. We listened to the story of "Pete the Cat and his Four Groovy Buttons," which is a story about subtraction.

LITERACY/TOPIC

Letter Sounds



We have learnt the letter sounds /x/ and /z/ and looked at words that begin with these sounds. We also listened to the stories of each letter sound, sang their songs, and made collages.
