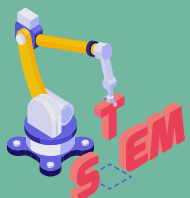
**SORTING ODD AND EVEN NUMBERS**

### THIS WEEK'S MAGNIFICENT MOMENTS

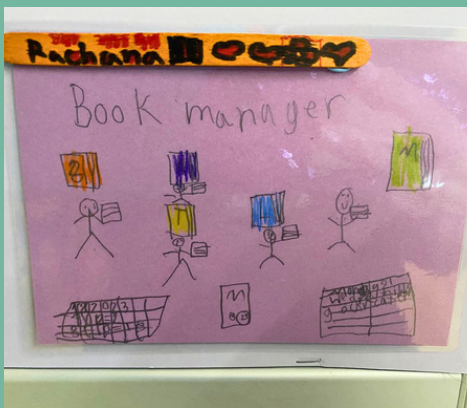
- We used LEGO to build base 10 blocks and sort odd and even number structures.
