
#### WELCOME TO OUR FIRST NEWSLETTER

#### NUMERACY

We started exploring colours and sang number songs. This week, the children have learnt to identify some colours, i.e., red, blue, and yellow, as well as some things that are associated with these colours.

#### LITERACY/TOPIC
