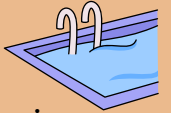
SCIENCE

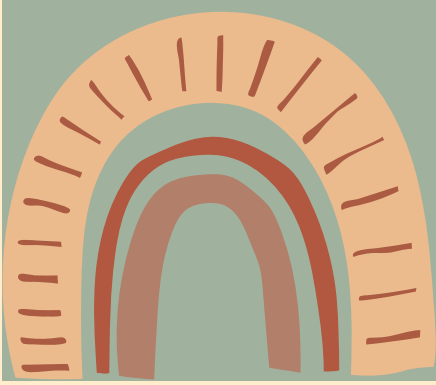

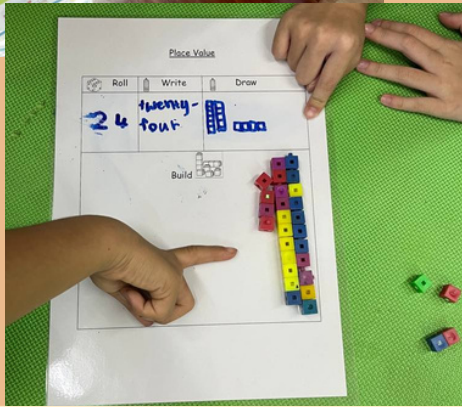
- ✓ A spelling list will be sent home on a Monday. Your child should practise nightly for the test on a Friday.
