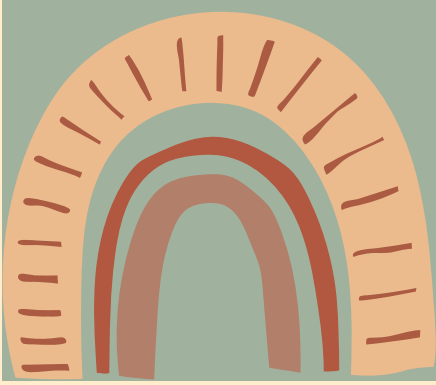


It has been a pleasure teaching Year 2B this term, and I am excited to welcome everyone back on October 23rd.
