Students improved their knowledge in using full stops, exclamation marks and question marks correctly.

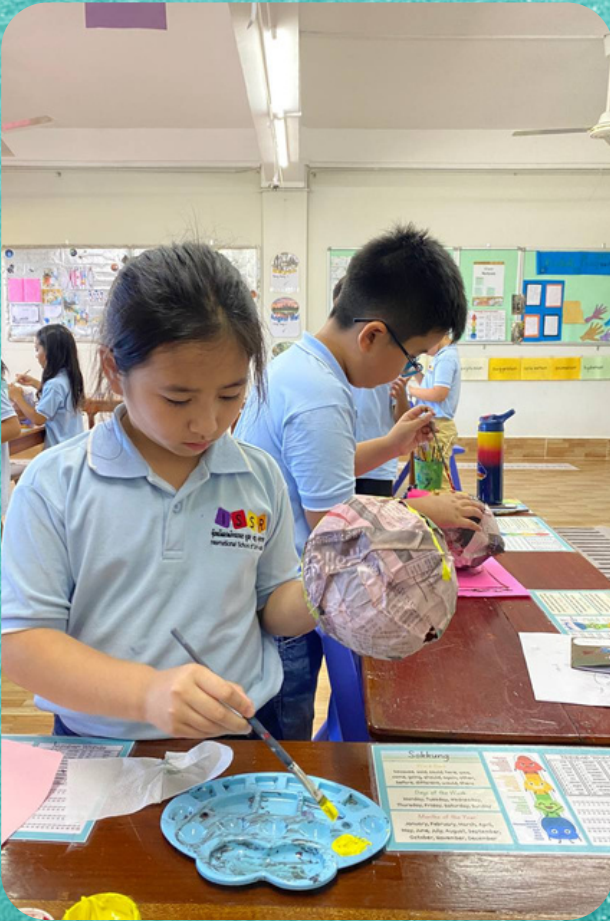


SCIENCE

This week in science, we have further developed our knowledge and understanding of what keeps plants alive.

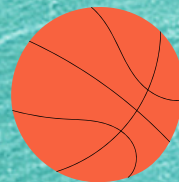

MATHS

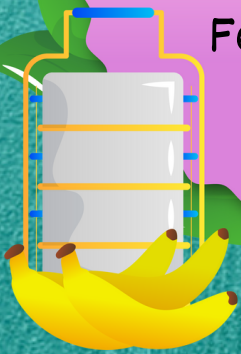
This week was spent focusing on our new unit, Shapes.
