LITERACY

Time flies so fast! We're already starting Term 2 with excitement as we begin Literacy with our spelling puzzle.

We've been reading and listening to traditional stories, recognizing homophones, identifying and understanding quantifiers, laying out direct speech, exploring apostrophes in text, and identifying the main parts of a story.



It's been a productive and engaging start to the term.

MATHEMATICS

In Maths, students have been doing a great job understanding the relationship between units of time and converting them. They have also been linking analogue 12-hour and 24-hour digital times. We kicked off this topic with a fun activity called Time Bingo and explored using the Clock tool. It has been a fun and engaging learning experience for everyone involved!



SCIENCE

In Science, we had an exciting start to week 1 as we delved into the fascinating world of the human body. We learned that bones move because pairs of muscles attached to them contract and relax. As part of an engaging activity, the students compared and drew diagrams of human skeleton to demonstrate what happens when a muscle in the arm contracts.

It was a hands-on and informative experience that helped deepen our understanding of how our bodies work.



In Arts and Design, we explored the concepts of Perspective and Cubism. We created artwork inspired by renowned artists such as Pablo Picasso, Albert Gleizes, Jean Metzinger, and Bridget Riley.

The students had the opportunity to experiment with layering their images and play around with different shapes and sizes to understand what works best.

It was a creative and thoughtprovoking exercise that allowed them to explore different artistic techniques and styles.
