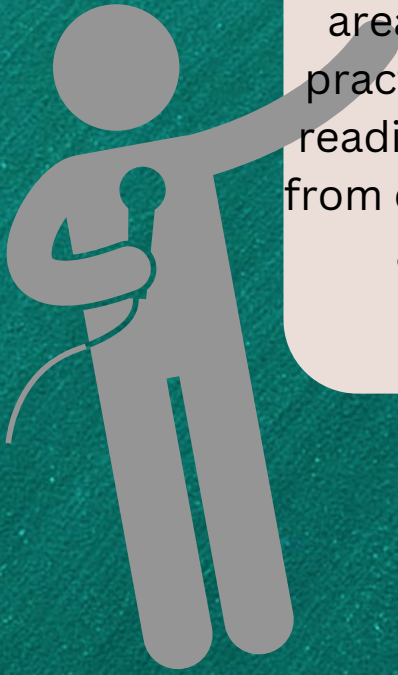


YEAR 5 NEWSLETTER

ENGLISH AND SCIENCE

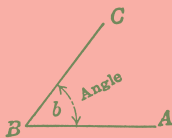
