All About Nursery Learning

Sensory play is a type of play activity that stimulates the children's senses. By encouraging the use of all of a child's sense through play, you can support cognitive growth, language development, fine motor skills development and much more.



This week in Nursery

In **Phonics**, we listened to "The Gingerbread Man" and "Brown Bear, Brown Bear, What Do You See?" stories. They have repetitive phrases that we can chant along with to help us tune into the rhythm of the language and the rhyming words. In **Numeracy**, we played the "Behind the Binoculars" game to practice number recognition. In this game, we use cupped hands to mimic binoculars. We used our binoculars to look at and name different numbers. In **Topic/Literacy**, we continued learning about the "Weather" through various activities such as doing the weather charade game, watching videos, finishing our weather craft, and listening to a book reading called "Weather".
