# The School Day

## Primary School Student

- Our school day starts at 7:55 for all students.
- Classes start at 8:00 and last for 55 minutes each.
- There is a 20-minute snack break in the morning and a 45-minute lunch break in the afternoon.
- Nursery/R1 students finish at 11:30.
- English Curriculum students finish at 16:00.
- Khmer curriculum students finish at 16:30/17:00.

## High School Student

- Our school day starts at 7:50 am for all students.
- Students must register using the R.F.I.D card system before 7:50
- Classes start at 8:05 am and last for 55 minutes each.
- There is a 15-minute break in the morning and a 50-minute lunch breaks in the afternoon.
- English Curriculum students finish at 16:00.
- Khmer curriculum students finish at 17:00.





## School Rules and Policies

- Parents should be familiar with the school policies that affect their children.
- School policies cover educational and managerial aspects of the school.
- Policies are available for viewing in the school office.
- The main school policies are outlined on the following pages.

## School Security

- All parents entering the HS & PS campus must wear their ID badges. When collecting children at PS, parents must display their ID badges before children are released to them. This is for the safety of all of our children.

## After School Arrangements

- Students can go home by bicycle, moto or school bus after school.
- School bus fees are discussed during the enrolment process.
- Parents must pick up their children on time according to their programme schedule.
- The school is not responsible for students who are left behind without special arrangements.

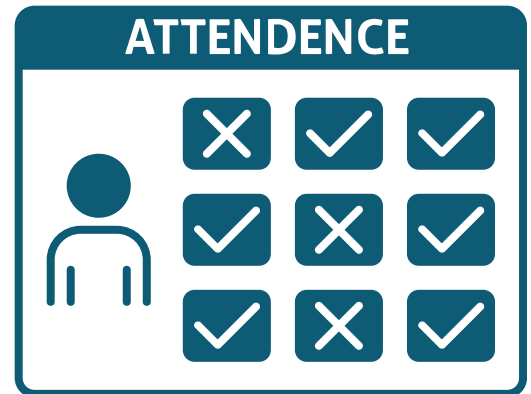
# Uniforms

- Primary School students' uniform is a red polo shirt for Foundation Stage and Key stage 1. A Light blue polo shirt for Key Stage 2.
- High School Students' uniform is a royal blue polo shirt with the school logo and dark trousers or skirt.
- No inappropriate clothing, footwear, jewellery, accessories or make-up are allowed.
- School PE kit and sports shoes are required for physical education lessons.
- Students must have a valid reason for not wearing the School/PE uniform and have presentable hairstyles.
- Uniforms must be worn for field trips and exams unless otherwise instructed.
- Parents will be notified of any recurring issues with uniform or appearance.



## Attendance

- Students should attend the full school term for better learning outcomes.
- The school calendar is provided in this booklet and online.
- Parents will be notified of any changes in the calendar by email, letter, Telegram and Edupage.



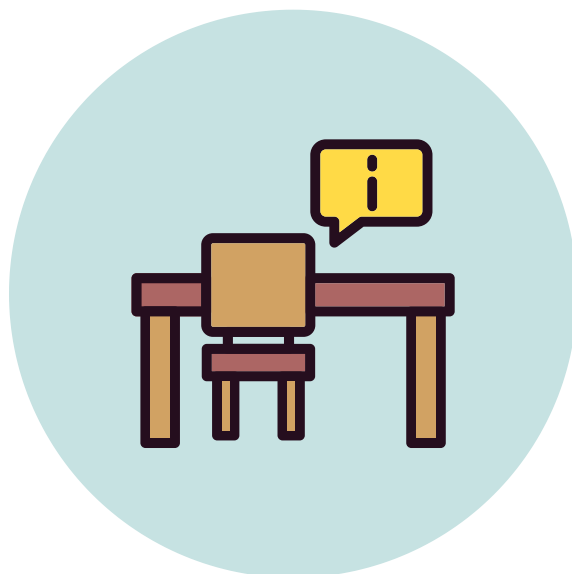
## Lateness

- Primary students attend classes from 07:55 to 11:30, 16:00, 16:30/17:00 depending on their timetable.
- High School students attend classes from 7:50 to 16:00/17:00, depending on their timetable.
- High School students must use an ID card to register their attendance and arrive on time.
- The school records the attendance of both High School and Primary School students on Edupage, which parents can access online.
- Parents must inform the school if their child will be late for any reason via Telegram or contacting the Admin office.
- Repeated lateness may result in a meeting with the Tutor, and the Principal.
- PS children arriving after 8:05am will need to be taken to the office to sign a late form, which will be given to the teacher.



## Absences

- Parents must notify the office or by Telegram before 07:50 for any absence or early departure of their child and state the reason and duration.
- Parents must inform the office if their child takes the bus.
- Parents must respect the teacher's decision if their child is sick at school.
- Students will not be allowed to call home unless it is necessary.
- Parents may receive a call or an email from the school if their child misses school often.



## Authorised and Unauthorised Absences



- The school differentiates between authorised and unauthorised absences and requires a note from a parent for valid absences.
- Unauthorised absences may result in a meeting with parents.
- Parents should avoid vacations during term time and notify the school if they do. These will be unauthorised absences.
- Parents should request the work schedule for their child if they are absent for long periods.
- Your child must bring an absence slip or medical certificate when they return.





## Administration of Medication

- Parents must inform the school of a child's illness and treatment required.
- Parents must label medicine and inform the admin office regarding dosage.
- The school will not force a child to take medicine or do procedures. If they refuse, we will notify parents.

## Mobile Phones and Electronic Devices

### Students may use devices only when:

- A teacher allows them for in-class activities or research in PS and HS.
- They need to contact their parents after school or arrange pickup from the front office.
- Devices must be stored in the provided locker and set to silent mode when not in use. The school is not liable for any loss, theft or damage of devices.
- If students break these rules, their devices may be taken away for the rest of the day their parents will have to come and collect them from school.
- Students must respect others' privacy with their devices.
